Founded December 4, 1978, as Everywoman's Resource Center, Child Care Aware® of Eastern Kansas is a non-profit organization that supports the development and learning of young children by offering programs and services that improve the quality and accessibility of child care for working families.

The agency continually meets or exceeds outcome benchmarks that measure the effectiveness of programs and services, and is known for their commitment to excellence. Recent recognition includes receiving the Non-Profit Award of Distinction from the Greater Topeka Chamber of Commerce in 2011, and receiving National Quality Assurance (accreditation) through Child Care Aware® of America in 2012.
