### Do You Know Someone Interested in Becoming a Child Care Teacher?

Child Care Aware<sup>®</sup> of Eastern Kansas is offering a new preparation program to those interested in becoming an early childhood teacher. This program, titled *Classroom Ready Child Care Teachers*, is a short-term training program that will enable participants to be eligible for hire as assistant teachers in local child care programs upon completion.

The program includes the KDHE health and safety required trainings for all new child care providers, a peer learning community session, interviewing tips and more. Participants will also receive a fingerprint background check, a new requirement in order to be eligible for hire at a child care program. The program

costs \$150 for each participant, but \$100 scholarships are available to Shawnee County residents.
