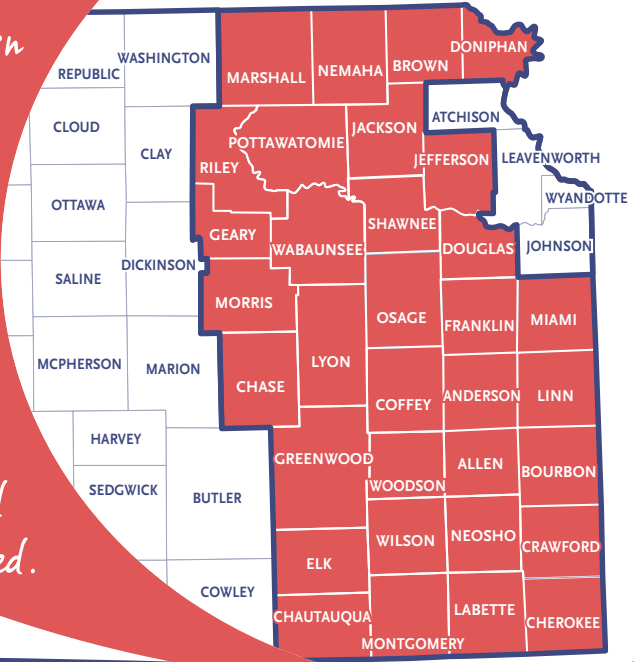

The agency's mission is to support the development and early education of children by improving access to resources for families, including high-quality child care options. Our goal is to improve child care and early learning programs so that every child has access to a high-quality program that gets them off to a great start in life!

The agency is supported through a variety of sources, including support from individual donors, grants and contracts (statewide, regional and local efforts), and special projects. Significant support is also raised by the annual Designers' Showhouse, a grassroots fundraiser in Topeka where area designers and craftsmen transform a selected home for public tours.
